- special programs for Visually Impaired – orientation & mobility; activities of daily living; low vision training;
- historic review of development of the organized education of visually impaired;
- foundations of Braille;
- tactile/relief materials for visually impaired etc.

The class is focused on building basic skills for working with Visually Impaired students and basic knowledge about this group of pupils.
