Short description of the course:

The aim of the course is to introduce students to pidgins, creoles and mixed languages as different types of contact languages, with a special focus on languages with African substrates. The course discusses the following questions: how these languages emerged, whether they form a structural group of their own and what they may tell us about the nature of language. The main characteristics in phonology, morphology, syntax and discourse structure of pidgins, creoles and mixed languages are analyzed with examples taken from different regions (West Africa, the Caribbean, Canada, the Indian Ocean and the Pacific).
